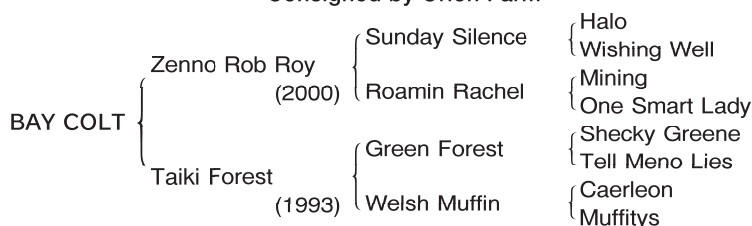


**BAY COLT Foaled May 3, 2007**
