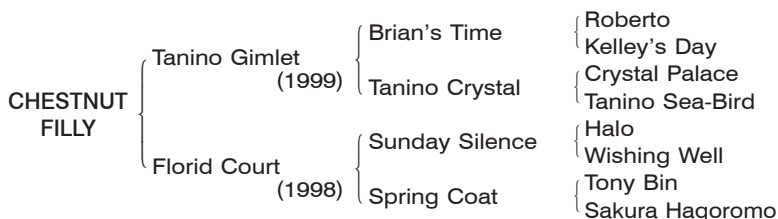


CHESTNUT FILLY Foaled February 3, 2011
