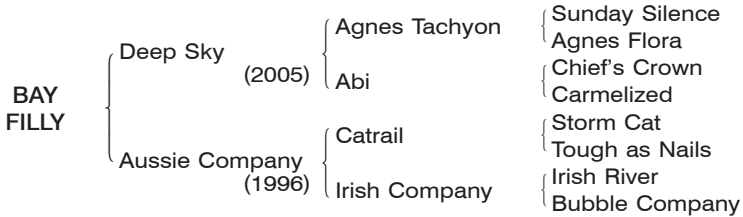


## BAY FILLY Foaled January 27, 2012
