

Going south from Osaka Station, you will stumble upon many spots popular with Japanese tourists such as temples, shrines and Osaka Castle. Since every temple and shrine offers a specific type of blessing, it's a good idea to plan ahead according to your current wish.



# Hozenji







### Not only does good fortune await you, gourmet food is just around the corner.

Wandering the alleys of the business district on the south side of, you will come across the deity Mizukake-Fudouson. This moss-covered statue is Hozenji's most defining feature. As the name Mizukake (splash with water) suggests, splash it with the provided ladle for some good luck in business, love, life, etc. Observing the moss that grew thanks to the water of many worshippers, you can feel the passage of time. Near Hozenji there are two alleys (yokocho) 80m in length and 3m in width. These extend to the east and west and house some long-established restaurants and bars. Enjoy Osaka soulfood such as okonomiyaki or kushikatsu. Why not make a small detour and explore the area?






### PICK UP!

OSAKA, THE CENTER OF RETRO STRUCTURES Stroll through the Kitahama area for the ultimate "Retro Japan" experience. Anywhere your eyes go, you will

spot a treasure from the past. There are many old buildings that have been refurbished as shops. Take a to enjoy some tea time stops around you. One building you shouldn't miss is the "Arai Building", originally a bank built in 1922. Inside you will find a sweets shop called "Gokan" with a cafe that has Western-inspired Taisho era interior.

## Heijo Palace Site Historical Park

#### If you go to the West of Nara station, you will be able to see Heijo Palace.

During the Nara period, about 1300 years ago, civilization blossomed in the heart of Yamatokoriyama City in Heijo-kyo (ancient name for Nara). Heijo Palace Historical Park is a state-owned park and a designated historical spot inside Nara City. It is a world heritage site listed as one of the Historic Monuments of Ancient Nara. This structure played a central role in the old history of Japan, and was the stage for many important events. From enthronements to welcoming foreign diplomats and guests, this location was the center of tradition.



POINT

The First Daigokuden | During the middle of the Nara era, the capital was temporarily transferred to Kuni-kyo and Daigokuden became the provincial temple for the Yamashiro Province. At that time, it was used for the country's most important ceremonies such as enthronement ceremonies and visits from foreign envoys. POINT

[ Suzaku Gate ] The front of the Suzaku Gate was an irreplaceable festival place for the people of the Nara period. Greeting and seeing off foreign envoys, festive singing and dancing and the emporer celebrating the beginning of the New Year was all held here.

It is now known as a popular tourist spot and is home to one of the oldest shopping streets in Japan called Mochiido Shopping Street. When you have the chance to come to Japan, Not to miss. Naramachi is also home to the Great Buddha which sits in Todai-ji temple. There are also many stylish cafes and variety stores located in the area that you can see while taking your bike around the neighborhood.


