

How To Use This PDF

This is meant as a simple accounting book to introduce the concept of book keeping to your child.

Print one copy of page 2 and 3 copies of page 3 then put them back through the printer, printing page 3 onto the blank side of all the papers.

Page 2 is the cover so have that on the bottom, face down. Fold the lot in the middle to make a book and staple along the crease to keep it in place.

When you first give your child the book, get them to add up their money and record the amounts in the first space on the first page. After that, whenever they receive more money they add it to the current total or if they spend some, they subtract it.


It is very simplified, meant as an introduction to keeping records. Once they get the basic hang of it, you can introduce them to the next stage or even accounting software.

The back cover has a goal chart. This is for keeping track of the goals they have aimed at and when they reached it.

Page 4 is a goal tracker. They start with their monetary goal and as the income comes in they deduct it from their goal so they can easily see how much more they need to hit their goal. Page 5 is an example sheet.

Page 6 is a printout for family jobs. Make sure it is clearly stated the rate and frequency for each job and when payday happens!
