Certain names resonate strongly within the halls of the Australian wine industry. Jim Barry is one of those names.

It was Jim's drive and community spirit that helped shape South Australia's Clare Valley as a benchmark in the world of Riesling and cemented its place as one of Australia's premier wine regions.

The Barry family name is synonymous with the Clare wine region and their deep ties to the local community continue to this day.

The hidden geological treasure of porous limestone, under the rich terra rossa soil, creates the ideal cellar by storing water for later use. From these gifts of the earth, the winemaker creates their distinctive signatures in wine.

The combined efforts of many outstanding grapegrowers and talented winemakers have ensured that Coonawarra has produced wines of a truly unique style and quality. Accounting for less than 1.5% of Australia's total wine production, these wines are now generally recognised as being amongst the greatest in the world.

Winemaking Notes

In the glass this wine shows a bright garnet red with a violet hue.

The nose opens with bright red fruits with nuances of spice, tomato leaf, and herb stuffing.

Red fruit flavours up front moving into olive and red current leaf, wild strawberries and cassis.

A classic Coonawarra Cabernet, the tannin is integrated giving line and length.
