2013 MUSEUM RELEASE KANTA RIESLING

'From acclaimed Mosel winemaker Egon Müller comes Kanta Wines, a passion project born from a love of South Australia and Riesling.'

The Museum Release is a series of Kanta wines only produced during exceptional vintages. A selection of finished wine is set aside and carefully matured to showcase its ageing potential.

Region:

Argyle Vineyard, Echunga, SA

Varietal Composition:

100% Riesling

Vineyard:

The Argyle Vineyard is a high altitude Adelaide Hills site that sits over 400m above sea level and is flecked with traces of iron stone. Rejuvenated in 1999, the original plantings date back to the 1840's making them some of the oldest vines in South Australia.

Vinification:

Fruit is hand picked and cold soaked for 8 hours. Fermentation is then allowed to commence naturally using the indigenous yeasts that occur in the vineyard. The wine is then held in tank on lees for over 6 months before being bottled and stored for a minimum of 5 years.

Tasting Notes:

Beeswax and honeycomb dominate the nose before leading into a delicate lime zest citrus. The palate displays lime marmalade with a hint of green apple on the finish supported by Kanta's signature striking texture and gentle acid line.
