Indian independent leader Mahatma Gandhi was impressed by Thoreau's claim. In 1907, about a year after the first satyagraha campaign in South Africa, he wrote a summary of India's debate, calling Thoreau's paper "Major abolition of slavery in America". "Cause", "he has written that" his example and work has become fully applicable to Transval Indians, "he wrote. That man, he did not teach him anything to prepare to practice on his own. He is one of the most ethical and great people in the United States. In the abolition of the slavery movement he
